There was a new solar project update from our contractor; he was optimistic about DSA timelines and expected that our installation could start in mid-February. There was some discussion about Bernasconi Camp, including the maintenance needs and the pricing of rentals by education groups. This topic will be brought up again in the future. B. Simpson introduced Elyse Morrison and shared that she had accepted the position of Administrative Assistant/Board Secretary to replace K. Cash when Kim retires in April.
