Pillar Highlight: Integrated Student Supports

Community schools are built upon four pillars, as introduced in the October newsletter. The Integrated Student Supports pillar focuses on the whole child by considering what needs students may have that when met prepares them for learning. When these needs aren't met, a student may struggle to be ready to learn. California Community Schools framework states that integrated student

supports are, "services that meet their (students) academic, physical, social-emotional, and mental health needs," and includes the "coordination of trauma-informed health, mental health, and social services." By asking students, staff and family members what they need, our schools can better identify and serve their communities, ensuring all students are receiving equal opportunity in their education. This could look different at every community school!
