WHAT NORTH STAR OFFERS:

North Star Services provides no-cost mental health services to students and families in Inyo County schools. Our team strives to empower clients to build skills and gain awareness to overcome the challenges in their lives. Our team offers school-based and community-based sessions including individual, group, family, parent-child, and teletherapy services. Typically we provide weekly sessions for 40-60min for 6-12wks. We have an office location for sessions in Bishop independent from school campus. Please contact our team with your questions and we look forward to supporting your student and family.

CONNECTING WITH SERVICES:

Review the included provider list for detailed contact information. When speaking with a provider, check their availability to take on new clients and confirm the provider will accept your insurance. Ask to schedule a free consultation visit to assess fit. Inquire if they could put you on a waitlist. If you are uninsured, or mental health services are not covered by your plan, many providers are willing to negotiate reduced rates or refer you to another provider.



TELEHEALTH SERVICES:

The North Star Team recommends reviewing your insurance coverage for mental health services. You can contact your insurance to request a list of in-network providers this may include in person and telehealth providers. Telehealth services have continued to expand rapidly. Telehealth providers often have availability and specialties to offer engagement faster than inperson providers. We encourage you to consider your options to support the well-being of your student, yourself, and family.
